For these next two weeks, you will have a choice of completing a Culmination Collage Project using several media forms to create a Photo Mosaic OR a pattern based drawing. YOU MUST CHOOSE ONE OF THE TWO TO COMPLETE FOR YOUR 3RD ROUND OF PACKETS/WORK AND SUBMIT TO GOOGLE CLASSROOMS.

OPTION 1: The Culmination Collage project will combine imagery from this year during your artistic career at PCHS. Please read the requirements below:

1. Must take a self portrait (meaning a selfie of you!) This will be your base image.

- 2. You must have a minimum of 60 photographs TOTAL in your mosaic collage (don't panic, I'll explain below) but there is no maximum.

 Completely up to you!
- 3. The FIRST 20 (or more) photographs used from your cellphone, external camera, or the PCHS website (or a combo of all). These first 20 will represent from the start of the year (meaning these are photographs you already have taken!) You may include but are not limited to, photographs of books, friends, teachers, and sports. You may use photographs of teachers and PCHS images directly off the website if you wish, but I WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY GOOGLE IMAGES OR STOCK IMAGES FOR YOUR FINAL.
- 4. THE NEXT 20 (or more photographs) used from your cell phone, external camera, or PCHS website. You will include 10 or more pictures of your artwork you have done over the course of the year and including work you have done over the Quarantine! (Think about all the work you did prior to me being your teacher and during this time of being your teacher) You should have a minimum of THAT INCLUDE 10 photographs of your drawings, shading practice sheets (photography students will be your actual photographs done prior to me and with me).

You all should have more than 10 pieces of artwork you have done for me, including photography students. Your photos count as artwork! You may use 20 photographs of your work you have done for me, your previous art teacher, or projects you've done outside of school. If you only have enough for 10, you may use 10 photos of your favorite Artists (and their work...and NO not music artists. Art Artists!RESEARCH if you need to)

5. THE LAST 20: The last 20 photographs you will use are images taken over the Quarantine time, meaning any photographs you have taken with your family, any photos of school work you have done during this time. I want this photo collage to represent who you are as a person and the memories that have MADE you who you are THIS SCHOOL YEAR. Please OPEN THE POWERPOINT/GOOGLE SLIDE TO SEE EXAMPLES AND DIRECTIONS OF THE SOFTWARE YOU WILL USE!

6. THE ARTIST STATEMENT: (DON'T PANIC!) An artist statement is a simple written reflection on WHAT you chose to use and WHY! Please answer the following questions in Paragraph FORM! You need a minimum of 10-12 sentences TOTAL! If you answer the questions below, you will be able to have more than enough to meet the requirements for the artist statement!

-Describe in detail the 60 images you chose (not each individual one, but overall, what was the theme? Who was specifically chosen? WHY?). What do they represent to you? Who did you choose to incorporate in your Culmination Collage? WHY?

-Describe in detail the memories that are associated with these images you chose for your collage! What was going on during this time? (Speaking specifically about my example, numerous images are of my artwork, my time during quarantine, and travel experiences before I came to PCHS. Here is where I would describe in detail WHY these memories are important to me).

-How can artwork, specifically this collage, represent a visual collection of memories? Do you feel collage (smaller images making a composite larger image) is the best way to communicate the visual memories? Or do you feel another artistic medium (paint, drawing, sculpture) would have been easier for you to communicate memories? TELL ME SPECIFICALLY WHY!

-Reflecting on the time you have been away from school, what memories have you made that you absolutely cherish and will remember forever? This is a unique time in history that we all will never forget! What do you miss most about PCHS and school? WHY?!

OPTION 2: PATTERN BASED DRAWING (IF YOU CHOSE NOT TO DO THE PHOTO COLLAGE)

- 1. You must have a minimum of 6-8 patterns for your FINAL pattern based drawing. This project can be done in pencil, pen, or sharpie.
- 2. You must complete the practice 4 Pattern Drawing Boxes (FOUND ON the Powerpoint/Google Slides).

- 3. 2 of these patterns from the practice sheet that you will turn in you should INCLUDE ON YOUR FINAL. MEANING I SHOULD FIND YOUR PRACTICE patterns in your final. Only 2 though! The rest of the minimum patterns required will be YOUR creation!
- 4. You must pick an object which could include (a found object like a cell phone, ear phones, fork spoon, or an alphabet letter. These are just examples.) This will be your POSITIVE space drawing (meaning it will be white and the rest of the drawing will be filled up with patterns.
- 5. **PLEASE OPEN THE GOOGLE SLIDES TO SEE DIRECTIONS AND INSPIRATION**




Where each number is, you will draw a new pattern! Remember 2 of them will come from the practice! Please see the last slides for more pattern inspiration!

STEP 6: Draw in the Patterns! Remember your Requirements! See requirements on the checklist document!!


