CELL PHONE POLICY:



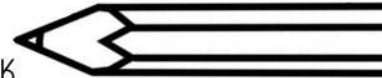

DISCIPLINARY PLAN AS FOLLOWS:

- First Occurrence: You will receive one verbal warning from me about a cell phone during class. It will be documented in Educator's Handbook.
- Second Occurrence: You will be asked to place in the charging station for the entire class near my desk which is secured, followed by a phone call home. It will be documented in Educator's Handbook.
- Third Occurrence: You will be asked to place in the charging station for the entire class period, followed by a phone call home, as well as admin referral. It will be documented in Educator's Handbook.
- Fourth Occurrence: You will be asked to place in the charging station for the entire class period, followed by a phone call home to schedule admin and family in person meeting. It will be documented in Educator's Handbook and referred to administration.
- Fifth Occurrence: You will be asked to place in the charging station for the entire class period, you will serve after school detention, and referred to administration for any additional discipline.

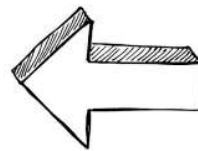
